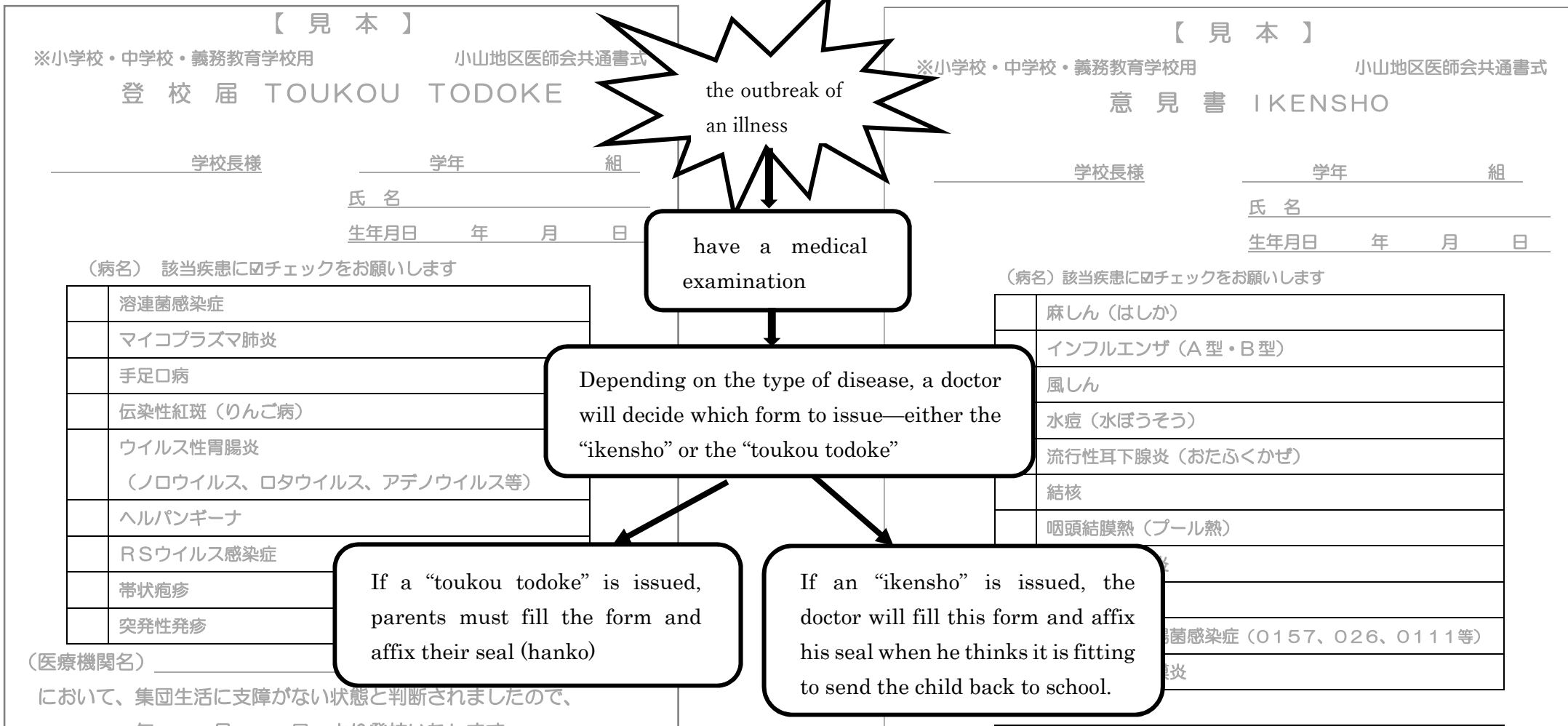


About “toukou todoke” and “ikensho”



(Reminders) ※This procedure is only applicable to medical institutions affiliated with Oyama District Medical Association. Other medical institutions may incur charges for the documents they will issue.

○ **Toukou todoke** (notice of permission to attend school filled by parents) ... After a medical examination, a doctor will issue this form when he has confirmed that the child’s illness will not cause any problem to other students at school. Parents must fill this form.

◇Make sure of these important information: the name of medical institution, the date of medical examination, and the date when it is possible for your child to go back to school. At the outbreak of an illness, please take your child for a medical examination immediately.

○ **Ikensho** (medical certificate filled by physicians)... The doctor who performed the examination will fill this form. It must contain his name and seal (hanko).

◇Illnesses such as water warts (mizu-ibo), impetigo (tobihi), and head lice (atama jirami) do not require temporary suspension from class. If your child has to leave school for these reasons, it will be counted as absence from class due to illness.
